This Transfer Articulation Agreement is governed by the general Transfer Articulation Agreement Memorandum of Understanding between Eastern Maine Community College (EMCC) and the University of Maine (UMaine). Current students and graduates who have been enrolled in or earned the identified degree from EMCC and are admissible to the University shall be eligible for credit evaluation under the terms of this agreement.

Admissions requirements: Successful Completion of the Associate in Applied Science in Business Management/transfer Option and a complete application for admission.

Other EMCC business and hospitality courses not listed above may not transfer to UMaine. Students should check with their academic adviser to ensure any other business course they choose to take at EMCC will be accepted for transfer at UMaine.

*A minimum grade of C- (or C for English Composition) is required for transfer credit to be awarded.

Special Notes Courses taken at EMCC in which the student did not earn the required grade to satisfy either transfer credit or degree requirements would need to be retaken at either UMaine or EMCC in order to earn the grade needed to count toward the degree at UMaine. Once enrolled at UMaine, the student would need to seek permission from his or her advisor and complete a domestic study away form to alert Student Records if they plan to take any courses at EMCC.

Prospective CPA students:

Students who intend to sit for the CPA (Certified Public Accounting) examination must have completed 150 credits including a baccalaureate degree and a minimum of 15 credits in accounting. One option recommended for University of Maine students is to complete the baccalaureate degree in business with a major in accounting and then complete the UMaine MBA. Students should strongly consider an internship in accounting sometime during their program.

^{*}General Education Requirement courses, Electives, the English Elective and CMJ 103 do not have to be taken in the order shown. Student may also choose to meet general education requirements by taking additional courses at EMCC that have been identified as meeting UMaine's general education requirements or they may choose to take them during May term, Summer session or January term at UMaine.

Degree Requirement Notes:

The minimum number of credits required to graduate with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration in Accounting is **120 credits**, in addition to earning the required credits, students must meet specific degree requirements which include course and grade requirements, specific elective requirements and general education requirements. Please see the current University of Maine catalog for details

Students anticipating an Accounting internship (MGT 396) in their senior year should consult with their advisor and plan their program carefully to free one semester for full-time work. Students could take





general education requirements during prior May terms, Summer Sessions or the January terms to free up time during their senior year or consider taking MGT 396 in the summer.

Students transferring from EMCC fill many of the Business Administration degree program electives with courses taken as part of their EMCC associate's degree program – students wishing to also complete a concentration with their Business Administration degree at UMaine will need to take additional courses beyond those listed in this agreement to complete the requirements to earn a concentration. Please check with your adviser for specific details.

Transfer students will be accorded the same standards and criteria for admission to a major degree sequence as UMaine students. All applicants accepted to UMaine's baccalaureate programs must fulfill the graduation requirements as identified in UMaine's academic catalog.
