Terms of Articulation Agreement University of Maine/Eastern Maine Community College EDUCATION

The purpose of this agreement is to recognize the compatibility of these respective programs to promote the transfer of qualified students and to provide the means for a smooth transition for Eastern Maine Community College's Associate in Applied Science Education students to the University of Maine's Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education.

Respective EMCC and UM officials will approve the following terms and course transferability by signing the attached Articulation Approval Form.

- 1. EMCC students will be accepted to the University of Maine based on individual academic excellence (a minimum cumulative 2.75 GPA or better) and available space in the program.
- 2. All transfer courses must be passed with a "C" or higher except for the Core classes: ECE 110, EDB 202, EDB 221, and ECE 216 which must be passed with a B- or better. Additionally, all professional courses must be passed with a B- or better.
- 3. EMCC students will be required to complete all UM Education requirements that do not have EMCC course equivalents in order to be awarded a UM Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education Degree.
- 4. EMCC students will be required to complete their student teaching requirement at UM.
- 5. Any EMCC course not listed in the agreement as equivalent* to a UM course will transfer elective credit if passed with a "C" or higher.
- 6. EMCC students transferring to UM will be eligible for the same financial aid and housing considerations as other entering students.
- 7. Students transferring must meet expectations for candidacy. Requirements include: passing scores on the Praxis Core, proof of fingerprinting, completion of the Key Assessments used in UMaine's EHD 202, EHD 204, and SED 302. The EMCC portfolio from Practicum III will provide evidence of mastery for the required candidacy portfolio.
- 8. This agreement may be reviewed at the request of either institution if substantive changes in courses or programs at either institution are implemented. Respective programs are responsible for appropriate revisions to this agreement.
