Program Description

The New England Board of Higher Education (NEBHE) has established a regional program under which qualified residents of the region may receive reduced tuition rates when attending college in another New England state. The major chosen must be one that is not available in the student's home state (as approved by the public institution in the home state) and is available for the tuition reduction by the institution the student plans to attend.

Important Dates for Transfer Applicants:

Transfer Admission Application Priority Date – Fall: March 1; Spring: January 1. Applying by those dates provides ample time for decisions to be made in time for housing and to allow students to register with their class.

Transfer Admission Application Suggested Date – Fall: June 1; Spring November 15. Students submitting applications after those dates will be reviewed for admission on a space-available basis (especially Nursing and Survey Engineering Technology) and for scholarships on a funds-available basis.

Transfer FAFSA Filing On-Time Deadline June 1. Late FAFSA information will be processed on a funds-available basis. Spring transfer applicants should file FAFSA as soon as possible. UMaine's FAFSA code is 002053.

2022-2023 UMaine NEBHE Flagship Match Scholarship Program for Transfer Students

The New England Board of Higher Education (NEBHE) has established the Regional Student Program (RSP) under which qualified residents of the region may receive reduced tuition rates when attending college in another New England state, participation in the RSP program is determined by the student's academic major. See reverse side for details. Students attending UMaine through the NEBHE RSP program are eligible for consideration for the scholarships listed below in addition to the substantially discounted tuition rates provided by the NEBHE RSP program.

UMaine NEBHE Flagship Award for Transfer Students: \$7,500 annually (3.0 cumulative transfer GPA)

UMaine NEBHE Leadership Award for Transfer Students: \$4,500 annually (2.5-2.99 cumulative transfer GPA)

Students will be awarded based on Academic Credentials, Residency and Tuition Rate. Any change to a student's tuition status will result in financial aid adjustments, including scholarships. This includes any waiver program or reciprocity agreement that results in non-resident students being charged the online or resident tuition rate. Students who qualify for the New England Board of Higher Education (NEBHE) Regional Student Program (RSP) are not eligible for Flagship Match Awards. The NEBHE Flagship Match Awards replace them.

Please Note: Scholarships are offered based on an enrollment of 15 credits per semester. Scholarships will be pro-rated to 80% of the full scholarship amount for students enrolled in 12-14 credits per semester. Students enrolled less than full-time (less than 12 credits per semester) are not eligible.

Transfers applying within one year of high school graduation or who have earned less than 15 college-level credits after graduating from high school and will be reviewed for merit awards using a combination of high school academic achievement and their college transcripts.
